To be well-behaved, a perennial must be:

1. Easy to grow in a wide variety of conditions
2. Proven reliably hardy for our area
3. Attractive leaves and/or flowers
4. Not need staking
5. Go at least 5 years before needing division
6. Must stay put without aggressive self-seeding or spreading underground
7. Reasonable size for small yards
